Introduction

- Could people read this as license to do whatever they want and assume God is ok with it? Why or why not?
- How is this text a call for humility?

Application

- What is your biggest takeaway from this text?
- What are these passages from Romans calling you toward in your life?
- What excites you about the Kairos moment Coker finds herself in?
- How can we be in prayer for you?
