



## Wisdom From Above Proverbs 3:5-8

### Introduction

The wisdom books of the Bible offer us practical advice on how to live a godly life. We find wisdom for relationships, business, charity, and more. We see wisdom for times of suffering, and even cynicism. What we find is that a life lived in the wisdom of God is the good life.

- How does wisdom lead us away from evil (vs. 7)?
- Why would this way of life lead to physical healing (vs. 8)?

- Where do you see an example of Godly wisdom in our world today?
- What would acknowledging God in all of YOUR ways look like?
- What is something you can do this week to intentionally seek God's wisdom?
- How can we be in prayer for you?
